CSONGRAD CUP 2020
RADIO CONTROLLED POWERBOAT COMPETITION

Aim of the competition: To provide a good racing opportunity and to promote the city of Csongrad

Date of race: 11-13 September 2020

Venue of race: Hungary, Csongrad „Villan-tó” (Holt-Tisza) (GPS: 46°41'35.3"N 20°09'52.9"E; 46.693128, 20.164706), the last 900m on gravel road.

Race categories: Endurance 3,5 - 7,5 - 15 – 27 (also stock classification in 3.5)

Classification: Individual and team competition. A team consists of 3 competitors (1 person for 3,5 class, 1 person for 7,5 class and 1 person for 15 or 27 class of the same club)

Requirements of participation: Model(s) meeting the regulations, a valid club membership, at least 2 pairs of crystals or 2,4GHz

Registration: via e-mail until 8 September to fsrnevezes@gmail.com

Registrations need to include: name, category, frequencies or 2.4GHz, AMB transponder numbers

Saturday banquet dinner will be held at the race venue (traditional fish soup with bread and red wine). Orders must be sent attached to the registrations.

Prizes: The first place team will win the Csongrad Cup for a year. The second and third place teams, and the 1-3rd place competitors of the categories will win prizes.

Rules: valid IMBRA rules (2x20 min heats + 30 min finals, regardless of nr. of competitors)

Accommodation: HOTEL RESERVATIONS MUST BE BOOKED INDIVIDUALLY!

Entry fee: First class 7000 HUF (4000 HUF for juniors), each additional class +1500 HUF

Protest fee: Protests can be handed in by the captain of the team to the main referee of the competition for a price of 5000 HUF. In case the protest is accepted, the fee will be paid back.

Other: Competitors are responsible for the damages caused to the rescue boat!

Competitors are responsible to take all protective measures and bring masks and disinfectants, according to virus regulations.
